**Note:** The objective of the Market Hog Show is to provide exhibitors an opportunity to develop skills in selecting, feeding, grooming and showing market hogs.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Hogs may be bred or crossbred, but must be of high quality in order to be eligible for premiums
2. Each exhibitor will be allowed to show up to two (2) animals.
3. Animals will be assigned to classes based on weight after all hogs have weighed.
4. Animals will be weighed upon arrival at the fairgrounds
5. Hogs not meeting the minimum weight limit (180 lbs.) or hogs exceeding the maximum weight limit (280) can be reweighed at the discretion of the livestock superintendent before noon on Wednesday
6. A maximum of 20 market hogs will be sold in the Market Sale. Sale order will be determined by the judge.

When determining Sale Order the Judge will give the chosen exhibitor a numbered card representing their sale order (20 hogs chosen for the sale and ten alternates. The handout numbers will be from 1 through 30.

**All entries are required to produce Health Certificate issued by Veterinarian. Multiply animals may be combined on one certificate. All tests required must be completed and indicated as such.**
