**Rules:**

1. Each exhibitor is limited to TWO market goats.
2. Does and wethers are eligible. Does shown in market class may not be shown in breeding stock class or dairy show. Wethers may not have testicles.
3. Market goats must have been owned by exhibitor a minimum of sixty (60) days.
4. Goats may be horned but horns should be tipped for safety.
5. Goats must be under one (1) year of age and must still have baby teeth.
6. Goats must weigh a minimum of 35 pounds.
7. Classes will be determined by weight.
8. A maximum of five (7) goats will sell in the Market Sale. Alternate candidates will be selected.
9. Shaving of goats is to be done in the grooming shed and all hair cleaned up.
