Special Rules for Meat Pens

1. Both does and bucks may be entered.
2. Trio Meat pens must be shown in groups of three (3).
3. Entries **must not** be over 12 weeks of age.
4. Only one meat pen and one Single Fryer per exhibitor will be allowed. No substitutions.
5. A pen of three (3) must weight a minimum of 9 lbs. (3 lbs. per rabbit) and a maximum of 16.5 lbs. (5.5 lbs. per rabbit).
6. A maximum of 4 pens will be sold.
7. No late entries will be accepted.
8. Exhibitor must own entry for 30 days prior to show date.

Special Rules for Single Fryer (under 4 months of age)

1. Grand Champion will go to Market Sale.
2. Both does and Bucks may be entered.
3. Single Fryer may not be shown as part of a meat pen,
4. Entries **must not** be over 12 weeks of age.
5. Single fryer must have minimum weight of 3 lbs. and a maximum weight of 5.5 lbs.
6. Exhibitor must own entry for **30** days prior to show date.

Additional Information and Regulations:

Note: Special rules and regulations may be listed for particular departments. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read, understand and apply all rules and regulations for each class entered.

1. Rabbits must be checked-in between 4-8pm on Monday.
2. Rabbits must have tattoo or name in left ear.
3. Rabbits must be entered by the published Pope County Fair Entry date.
4. Each entry must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of rabbits and should make periodic checks.
6. The Pope County Fair reserves the right to refuse entry to the show and to remove from the show all diseased, sick, and/or unsightly specimens,
7. Rabbit pens should have food and water bowls emptied, cleaned and left upside down in pen after animals are removed. Individuals in violation of this rule will forfeit premiums on these animals.
8. Rabbits will not be placed if deemed unworthy by the judge.
9. The Fair Association will not provide feed for rabbit exhibits. Each exhibitor is responsible for feeding and watering their animals.
