**Rules and Regulations**

1. Steer ownership deadline is May 15
2. Steer must weight a minimum of **900\* lbs.**
3. Steer must be castrated (no bulls) and must be dehorned
4. All animals must be beef breeds or cross breeds
5. All animals must be fitted, well-groomed and must have been on feed for **120 days** prior to showing.
6. A maximum of 6 steers will sell.
7. Sale order will be based on judge's placings of the animals.
8. Exhibitors must show their own animal. When extenuating circumstances exist preventing the owner from showing the animal, the junior will contact the Livestock Superintendent prior to day of show. An injury incurred on day of show would result in special consideration. Livestock Superintendent will contact no less than three members of the livestock committee to make the final decision as to whether or not circumstances warrant another junior exhibitor being allowed to show the animal.
9. Classes will be determined by weight.
10. Animals will be weighted between 12 Noon and 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday of the fair and between 8:00 A.M. and 12 Noon on Wednesday of the fair. If the required minimum weight is not met, animals may be reweighed prior to 12 Noon on Wednesday of the fair.
