RABBIT EXHIBITS– OPEN RULES AND REGULATIONS

Application for Entry - All applications for entry in Open Department must be made to Pope County Fair Livestock.

Note: Special rules and regulations may be listed for particular departments. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read, understand and apply all rules and regulations for each class entered.

1. Rabbits must be checked-in between 4-8pm on Monday.
2. Rabbits must have tattoo or name in left ear.
3. Rabbits must be entered by the published Pope County Fair Entry date.
4. Each entry must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of rabbits and should make periodic checks.
6. The Pope County Fair reserves the right to refuse entry to the show and to remove from the show all diseased, sick, and/or unsightly specimens,
7. Separate classes will be established for each breed. If there are less than five animals of a breed entered. Breeds of similar origin may be combined for show purposes.

8. Judging of purebreds will be in accordance with ARBA standards on weights and disqualification. This is not a sanctioned show. Rabbits will be shown by breeds.
9. Rabbits will not be placed if deemed unworthy by the judge.
10. Entries are limited to (7) per individual.

1. Senior Buck – over 6 months of age
2. Senior Doe – over 6 months of age
3. Junior Buck – under 6 months of age
4. Junior Doe – under 6 months of age
5. Grand Champion Rosette
6. Reserve Champion Rosette
7. Best of Breed Rosette
8. Best Opposite of Breed Rosette

American Fuzzy Lop, American Sable, English Angora, French Angora, Satin Angora, Britannia Petit, Standard Chinchilla, Dutch, Dwarf Hotot, English Spot, Florida White, Harlequin, Havana, Himalayan, Jersey Wooley, Lilac, Holland Lop, Mini Lop, Polish, Netherland Dwarf, Mini Rex, Rex, Rhinelander, Silver, Silver Marten and Tan.

Large Breed Rabbits

American, Giant Angora, Californian, Champagne De, Argent, Checkered Giant, Giant and American Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Crème De Argent, Flemish Giant, Hotot, English Lop, French Lop, New Zealand, Palomino, Satin and Silver Fox.
