**Note:** For Halter Classes, only the horse will be judged on conformation, condition, and soundness. The horse should be clean, well-groomed and fitted for his/her type. The horse's feet should be cleaned and either trimmed or properly shod. Any clean, well-fitting halter will be appropriate. Personal appearance of showman will be neat, clean, well-groomed, attentive, and courteous and in compliance with dress codes.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. **Age divisions are determined by age of youth at first day of fair.** The show is open to all qualified Pope County Youth ages 5 – 19 for performance, timed, and halter events. Participants may exhibit during the first county fair after high school graduation, but not beyond that.
2. **Rules are in accordance with 4-H Horseshow Rules and Regulations.**
3. Only two (2) animals per exhibitor for halter division, and two (2) animals for performance and timed events. **Only one (1) animal per class.**
4. Registration deadline is posted online. **Absolutely no late entries accepted.**
5. Horse Health: Horses / ponies must be healthy and sound. A current calendar year negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) test is required. Horses will be checked against Coggins test papers on day of show.
6. **Stallions are not allow to compete or be present on the grounds.**
7. Ponies shall be measured and certified by club or chapter leaders. Maximum measurement is 13.3 hand or 55 inches.
8. **Horse / Pony must be owned or leased by exhibitor 90 days prior to entry.** Two members of a family may jointly care for and show one animal, but this animal may be shown only one time in each class. Pee Wee, Junior, and Senior designation refers to the exhibitor's age and not the horse.
9. Dress Code: Neat western attire with long sleeve shirts or t-shirt for speed classes and boots.
10. All exhibitors must show good sportsmanship throughout the show. Horses / ponies must be kept under control or be disqualified. Cruelty to or rough handling of animals is also grounds for disqualification.
