Judging- Wednesday noon Open, then Junior

1. Exhibitors are to bring their birds day of show. Show will start at noon. Exhibitors are **limited to 3 entries**. This department will not be eligible for market sale.

3. Registration papers should be available for inspection upon request of the livestock superintendent.

4. Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of their animals if caged at fairgrounds. This includes making daily checks on them, providing food and water, and gathering any eggs.

5. Separate classes will be established for each breed. If there are less than 3 animals of a breed entered, breeds of

similar origin will be grouped together for show purposes.

Registration papers should be available for inspection upon request of the livestock superintendent.

6. There will be no late entries.

7. All birds must have leg or wing bands (leg bands preferred) and be accompanied by papers proving a current negative test for pullorum-typhoid. Birds will be tested off-site.

8. Sick, neglected, or dirty birds will be scratched from the competition and be removed from the fairgrounds.

9. Any individual bird may only be shown in ONE class. Ex. If you are showing a bird as a Cock then that bird cannot also be part of a trio.
