## **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Exhibitors are limited two (2) Market Lamb entry. One (1) lamb will be edible for the market sale. No substitutions allowed.
- 2. All lambs must have lamb teeth, no permanent teeth showing.
- 3. Both ewes and wethers may be shown.
- 4. All sheep should be slick shorn to ¼ inch. Any unshorn or long haired/woolly sheep will be disqualified.
- 5. Entries must weigh a minimum of 80 lbs.
- 6. Animal must have minimum Body Condition Score of two (2).
- 7. A maximum of Nine (9) market lambs will sell in the market sale.
- 8. Lamb must be bona fide property of exhibitor.
- 9. <u>All Lambs must comply with Arkansas Health Regulations.</u>
- 10. Lambs will be inspected on grounds. No lamb showing symptoms of disease, particularly foot rot, sore mouth, ring worm, sheep pox, and scrape will be allowed to show.
- 11. Sheep may be shown with or without halters.
- 12. Sheep will weigh-in wearing a halter only.
- 13. No choke chains will be allowed. Market Lamb classes will be determined by weight.
- 14. Penning assignments are final. If an animal is not in the assigned pen the exhibitor will be asked to stall entry in assigned pen. Noncompliance will result in exhibitor will be asked to leave. (Prior to the Pope County Fair check pen assignment chart at popecountyfair.com. Then contact Sheep Superintendent with any concerns).
