- 1. Poultry must be inspected and checked in at the arena. Poultry will stay in the pens you bring them in and will stay in the arena. The top 25 will be penned and the other pens will go back home and be brought back on Saturday morning for pullet sale.
- 2. Poultry will be checked in on Wednesday from 8 am to 10am before the show at 1pm.
- 3. Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of their animals, and should plan to make daily checks on them, provide food and water, and gather any eggs.
- 4. Poultry pens should have food and water containers removed from the cages and be completely cleaned after animals are removed.
- 5. The fair association will NOT provide feed for poultry exhibits. Each exhibitor is responsible for the daily feeding and watering of their animals, as well as daily clean-up.
- 6. Pine Shavings should be used to line the bottom of cages with bottoms and placed under open-bottom cages.
- 7. There will be NO late entries
- 8. All birds must have leg or wing bands (leg bands preferred) and be accompanied by papers proving a current (within 30 days) negative test for pullorum-typhoid. Birds will be tested off=site prior to the fair. Wing testing will be the only allowable method of testing birds.
- 9. Sick, neglected, or dirty birds will be scratched from competition and removed from fairgrounds.
- 10. An exhibitor is expected to be present for the poultry show, market sale (if eligible to sell), and pullet sale. If the exhibitor is not present at the show, the entry will be scratched, If the exhibitor is not present at the market sale (if eligible to sell) or arrangement made by 5 p.m. on Friday, the next eligible seller will sell.
- 11. 4-H Pullet Project chicks: You must return 3 birds per set.
- 12. Exhibitors are expected to attend and attend the pullet sale Saturday morning if participating in the 4-H chain.
- 13. Exhibitors will be expected to handle birds during the poultry show, market sale, and pullet sale.
