GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE PREMIUMS LISTED IN THIS CATALOG ARE BEING OFFERED TO POPE COUNTY EXHIBITORS **ONLY**. ALL ITEMS ENTERED IN THE POPE COUNTY FAIR MUST HAVE BEEN FINISHED SINCE THE PREVIOUS FAIR BY A RESIDENT OF POPE COUNTY, OR A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF A POPE COUNTY 4H CLUB, FFA CHAPTER, OR EXTENSION HOMEMAKERS CLUB, OR COUNCIL.

WITHIN THE EDUCATIONAL DIVISION ENTRIES, ITEMS WILL BE JUDGED ON THEIR OWN MERIT. FIRST PLACE WINNERS IN EACH CLASS WILL RECEIVE BLUE RIBBONS, SECOND PLACE RED RIBBONS, AND THIRD PLACE WHITE RIBBONS.

THE EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED TO FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WITH ALL THE REGULAR RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE FAIR AND WITH OTHER RULES IN THE CLASS AND DEPARTMENT APPLICABLE TO THEIR EXHIBITS.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE LABELED WITH EXHIBITORS NAME, AGE, AND ADDRESS OF EXHIBITOR TOGETHER WITH THE DIVISION, AND CLASS OF EXHIBIT. TAGS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT CHECK-IN BUT IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH EXHIBITOR TO PUT TAGS ON.

THE DIVISIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS-

YOUTH AGES 4-9YRS OLD

JUNIOR AGES 10-19 YRS OLD. PARTICIPANTS MAY ENTER AS JUNIOR DURING THE FIRST COUNTY FAIR FOLLOWING HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION, BUT NOT BEYOND THAT.

SENIOR AGES 20-75

SENIOR PLUS AGES 75-??

NOTE: THE ELIGIBILITY RULES ARE DIFFERENT FOR THE MARKET DIVISIONS- SEE LIVESTOCK RULES AT popcountyfair.com/livestock

THE FAIR ASSOCIATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WITHDRAW, BY PUBLIC NOTICE PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FAIR, ANY OR ALL PREMIUMS OFFERED HEREIN. THE POPE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE IN ANY WAY FOR EXHIBITS, OR PROPERTY OF ANY KIND ON THE FAIRGROUNDS OR IN ANY FAIR BUILDINGS, BUT WILL FURNISH THE NECESSARY NUMBER OF WATCHMEN DURING THE FAIR.

REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE FAIR, ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CLAIM AND TAKE CHARGE OF THEIR EXHIBITS, PERSONALLY SUPERVISE AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR REMOVAL BETWEEN 10AM-6PM ON SUNDAY AND 10AM -4PM ON MONDAY FOLLOWING THE FAIR. NO EXHIBITS SHALL BE REMOVED PRIOR TO THESE TIMES. ANY UNCLAIMED EXHIBITS AFTER 4PM ON MONDAY FOLLOWING FAIR BECOME THE SOLE PROPERTY OF THE POPE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
